

BETHEL TRIP : CUMBRIA & LANCS : MARCH 24-26 2007 (3-day) draft

Saturday: Leave Carlisle at 7am, pick up at Penrith, Preston & Padiham. Stop(s) on the way at Service Area; there are facilities for tea & coffee (30p), cold drinks (50p) and emergency toilets on the coach. Bring a packed lunch if you wish, for the journey.

Arrive 12.30pm at **Wightwick Manor** (Probably the UK's best Arts & Crafts home - admission included). Arrive at our high quality Hotel 5.30pm. Pre-dinner drinks available in the comfortable lounge bar. 7.30pm **3-Course Dinner** (included). Prayers usually said individually or by each family party; staff tips at your discretion, on the table (for waitresses) or in your room (for housekeepers).

Sunday: Full English [Buffet] Breakfast in the hotel Dining Room, included in tour price. Leave hotel at 9.15am. **British Museum** 10.15am. Inclusive faith-building **Bible Tour in British Museum or British Library**. (Choice from 2 *new* tours both at approximately same time: "**The Origins of Writing & Language**" and "**The Origins of False Religion**") Please dress smart casual, bring bible. Group photo in the new Museum Atrium area*, with free large colour print posted to all travellers a few days after the trip. Leave Museum 12.15. Coach takes us to Tower of London for inclusive **Boat Trip** with commentary up the Thames to Westminster Pier. Packed lunch included. Visit to **Buckingham Palace** gates, with some theocratic commentary of sights in London. Some free time in **Regent Street (Libertys, Hamleys, etc)**. Back to hotel in good time; pre-dinner drinks (not included) in the comfortable lounge bar.

7pm - 10pm **Charleston Evening Buffet Dinner Show** with **live music** by top class Charleston duo (ex-Charleston Chasers, Debbie Arthurs & Nick Gill). Optional 1920s dress and dancing [some instruction given]! —the happiest music ever!

Monday: Depart hotel 9am (cases on coach). Visit to **London Bethel**, with several sit-down video tours also, and optional tour of Bible Displays in the Bethel lobby "**How The Bible Came to Us**". Depart London 12noon. Arrive home at around 6.30pm onwards.

Who can come: Any publishers and their friends, from any congregation, including approved unbaptised persons.

Cancellation & Deposits: All places can be immediately secured with a deposit (£15 minimum), and must be fully paid for by **2 weeks prior to trip**, latest. Please phone me if an emergency arises; if we are able to re-allocate your seat, you will get a refund less any costs if applicable. The content of the trip may need to be varied without notice, and updates are usually issued to local coordinator as changes are made.

Insurance: The coach company and the venues will have cover for their liabilities, but do take out insurance if you wish. Please remember to guard all valuables at all times. Any complaints should be made to Derek in the first instance rather than direct to any other provider of services. Parents are reminded to strictly constrain the behaviour and noise of their party, especially while in the hotel and on the coach. Please keep noise on the coach to a minimum. Wheelchairs by advance request, for all venues (donation basis, or free). Some detail or timing may alter if circumstances require it.

Cost: The trip currently costs £135 per person, assuming 47 persons approx.
